



Podcast Transcript for June 1, 2025

Friends, this is a Clock Prophecy Alert for June 1, 2025.

The Day of Ascension on Thursday came and went without the start of harvest, so we now watch for the *first Trumpet* during the Summer.

This may take place just after a declaration for peace and safety, possibly in the Middle East or elsewhere.

Many end time teachers are already pointing to a Fall Rapture, but the first Fruits of harvest are a Spring crop, with Autumn reserved for the ingathering of grapes, who are the dead in Christ.

It is the Summer (wheat) gathering that marks the removal of living Church saints, but it will be the events of the 2nd and 3rd *Trumpets* that tell us which Spring the harvest will begin.

I expect a dramatic setup in the second half of this year, both because of the First Trumpet and also because of the head wound event shortly after.

It is actually the head wound that signals the imminence of the *2nd Trumpet* in the Spring, meaning the fulfillment window becomes very short once the *7th Seal* opens.

We previously measured two prophetic hours from July 7, 2023 in relation to the Feast of Dedication, giving us a two hour marker that fell last December, but if instead we measure two hours and 58 minutes – which was the time shown to me in the vision – the result brings us to mid-August of this year.

I won't give an exact date in August because we don't claim to know a date certain for any future event, but August is a prime candidate for our progression to the *first Trumpet* in light of current events.

This would also give us more more certainty about the start of the harvest next Spring.

I have written a song about the rise of the first Beast and will be uploading that a little later, but for now you'll hear a brief excerpt at the end of this Alert just to give you an idea what's coming.

Stay tuned for a possible written update later in June, meanwhile God bless as you continue to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Churches:
