



Podcast Transcript for September 6, 2025

Friends, this is a Clock Prophecy Alert for September 6, 2025

As you know, I expect the harvest to begin during the Spring rather than the Fall.

The Jewish religious calendar begins in the month of Nissan, the same month Jesus was crucified.

This Rapture theology is based on the four major crops of Israel and the ingathering of four harvest groups in the Vineyard parable of Matthew 20. See my article about this for an identification of the pre-dawn group and how this connects to Matthew 27.

We see all four crops again in Revelation 6:6, each representing one of the four harvest groups.

I believe we should be looking at the seasons and archetypes rather than dates on the calendar, for one because Jesus said he would gather us at a time we are NOT expecting!

The reason no one can give us a date for the Rapture is also because according to Jesus the harvest will be divided, therefore no one date applies to everyone!

Note that in Matthew 20 the four groups are paid in an order they don't expect, which is why Jesus said that many who expect to be first will instead be last, and vice versa.

We see Elijah as an archetype for the divided harvest, whose time of departure pertained only to him, and thus Elisha remained to be gathered at a later time.

The words, *Many are called but few are chosen*, refers to this early gathering, which explains why Jesus says in Luke 12:36 that we should watch for him when he will return *FROM* the wedding.

While some will be first, others will be last!

If you think about it, the four groups of harvest in the Vineyard parable is God's mercy upon those who are less prepared than others, which is why rapture is not a condition for salvation.

I have identified the four groups of harvest by their associated crops, therefore the first fruits are the 144,000 Hebrew princes as stated in Revelation 14:4.

I realize there can be a first fruits in each harvest, so perhaps there will be some sort of overlap, but it should be clear that barley IS the first fruits of the harvest year.

Next is Summer wheat, which we relate to Pentecost, and which I believe represents the Church saints who are gathered in the Summertime.

The harvest of Fall grapes takes us to Revelation 14:18, which are the dead in Christ awaiting resurrection, referring to those in harvest group three.

Finally, the harvest concludes with Winter olives used to make oil, thus it is the final Rapture group of those who are alive and remain at the last trump!

That is why Jesus said we should to pray that our flight be not in Winter, because no one wants to be last!

Now let's look at the broader timeline which I believe could end in 2029.

Before the Summer, we did a reverse count of 1,260 days from the upcoming US Presidential election in 2028, which was why I expected the head wound and the start of early harvest last May.

The fact these things didn't happen means that the final 42 months in Revelation 13 won't be based on the date of the upcoming Presidential election, so we want to look at a later anchor point.

My earlier work with the Clock placed the 7th Trumpet in the Spring of 2029, therefore I believe we need to examine the week of Sukkot, or Tabernacles, in that year.

Also, as a reminder, this eschatology anticipates only a final 3 and a half years from the point at which the harvest begins. I have discussed this at length in earlier messages.

Sukkot will be the last week of September in 2029, the Feast I believe Jesus must fulfill at his second coming when he descends upon the Mount of Olives.

If the span of time between 2027 when the Man-child reaches maturity and 2029 brings the war of the Lamb against the beast to an end, that would include the one hour on the Clock the Antichrist is given to rule over Europe.

If we subtract 1,260 days from the only Sabbath in the final week of September in 2029, the result is the day that the Man-child reaches his 12th birthday on April 17, 2026!

This could mean that the Man-child will be caught up before his 13th birthday, which I believe is likely since these saints must be prepared for their mission before they can be returned to overthrow the nations!

Keep in mind that barley can be gathered throughout the Spring, therefore we don't need to focus on just one particular date during that or any other season.

We aren't called to mark our calendars, rather we are called to walk by faith, so keep watching as you continue to hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches:

"Behold, I come quickly!"
