



Podcast Transcript for October 6, 2025

Friends, this is a Clock Prophecy Alert for October 6, 2025.

I am aware of the Rapture call being made for October 6 and 7, but we are not expecting the harvest to begin at this time.

I want to talk about something that happened in the early days of my ministry that vectors to this Fall and why I am watching for the first Rapture in the Spring of 2026.

One evening in May of 2012, I was waiting for someone outside a Chick-fil-A restaurant. It was a beautiful Spring evening about 7 O'Clock, and stars were just starting to show up in the night sky.

I was actually looking up at the stars when almost directly above me at a distance of what seemed like maybe 10 miles, a fireball exploded that would be about the size of a dime held at arms length.

The color of the explosion was red and orange and it only lasted a second or two. I immediately looked at my watch and it was 6:57 PM.

When I got home, I checked 6:57 on the Clock and it vectored to May 7, 2017, almost exactly five years into the future.

As you know, any date between September 2, 2016 and July 12, 2019 fell during the Black Ring that separated the AM and PM layers on the Clock.

Because I didn't expect us to reach Critical Mass outside the AM layer at that time, I never discussed what I saw in May of 2012.

As you know, we entered the second Black Ring on the Clock at 6 PM in late March of this year, and since every time vector on the Clock repeats every 3,129 days, we are once again approaching 6:57 on the Clock!

This Alert is to let you know that Clock time 6:57 will be the week of Barack Obama's 666-adjusted birthday at the end of November!

You can see this Clock vector below, as well as citations for the Greek and Hebrew in Strong's, whereas the Hebrew word linked to 657 occurs in Daniel 8:25!

I believe early harvest will begin next Spring if indeed we reach Critical Mass in the weeks ahead, so keep watching as you continue to hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches:

“Behold, I come quickly!”

עִפּוֹס 'ep̄eç, eh'-fes; from H656; (sometimes like H6466) cessation, i.e. an end (especially of the earth); often used adverb, no further; also the ankle (in the dual), as being the extremity of the leg or foot:—ankle, but (only), end, howbeit, less than nothing, nevertheless (where), no, none (beside), not (any, -withstanding), thing of nought, save(-ing), there, uttermost part, want, without (cause).

Concordance Results Shown Using the KJV

Strong's Number **H657** matches the Hebrew עִפּוֹס ('ep̄es), which occurs 44 times in **43** verses in the **WLC Hebrew**.

TOOLS  **Dan 8:25** And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify *himself* in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but **H657** he shall be broken without **H657** hand.
