

Podcast Transcript for April 10, 2026

Friends, I want to begin by making a few points about Israel.

Those who believe the Church is true Israel and that God has broken his covenant with the descendants of Abraham have either been deceived by Satan or they are consciously working on behalf of Satan.

The Hebrew princes who make up the 144,000 will rule the Earth with Christ and will reach 13 years of age on April 17, 2027.

I recently learned that in Judaism, the tenth of Nisan on the Jewish calendar is celebrated as the very day the Israelites crossed the Red Sea during the Exodus.

In the Clock Prophecy, we associate this event with the catching up of the Man-child and the start of early harvest, a Spring event as opposed to a Fall event.

The tenth of Nisan floats on the Gregorian calendar between March 20 and April 20 every year, and while this year it fell on March 28, it will fall on exactly the Man-child's birthday -- April 17 -- in the year 2027!

This date will not repeat on the tenth of Nisan again until 2073, and there is one additional reason I believe it has prophetic significance, and that is the fact that in 2027 this date falls on the Sabbath.

This raises an obvious question: *Does the alignment of the tenth of Nisan and the Man-child's 13th birthday next year argue against the start of early harvest this Spring?*

The answer is that I don't know, but I continue to believe that we have come to the end of the two hour delay and will reach Critical Mass at any time.

If for some reason we do not see the 2nd Trumpet this Spring, it could occur later in the year and bring us to the 3rd Trumpet in the Spring of 2027, where it would mark the conclusion of the Man-child's Exodus at that time.

As far as my understanding is concerned, the Clock Prophecy has nowhere to go after the end of the ninth Hour in early 2028.

Could the head wound event occur later in 2026? Yes, but that would not mean the start of early harvest this year, which is why there may be a gap of several months between the 2nd and 3rd Trumpets.

Now let's look at what is going on with Iran as the US military campaign there unfolds.

The current state of affairs is a perfect setup for an airlift out of Jerusalem, meaning that the IRGC itself may trigger the Revelation 12:15 scenario as opposed to the 2nd Trumpet.

It could also be a combination of the two, meaning things could connect here on every possible level, including the start of early harvest before Summer!

As you know, there is an anti-Israel bias in our media, which is only getting louder as the forces of darkness prepare for the rise of 666.

Remember that Paul in Romans 11 says God has not abandoned his ethnic brethren and that it was God who blinded the Jews for the sake of the world.

Likewise, according to Paul, it will be God who removes that blindness after the fullness of the gentiles has been accomplished, at which time ALL Israel shall be saved!

Since the Church is not blind as to who the Messiah is, the Church cannot be Israel.

As for Zion, this word was the original name for the City of David, an area near the temple mount that later became part of Jerusalem.

The restoration of Zion is prophesied in many passages of scripture, including Isaiah 66:8, Ezekiel 20:34, Hosea 3:4,5, Amos 9:13-15, Psalm 89:29-37, and others.

Ironically, those who say God has walked away from Israel, annulling his covenant with them, refer to their exclusionary doctrine as *Covenant theology*, with the outrageous claim that Paul himself authored it.

Again, it is Paul in Romans 11 who refutes it!

In the same passage, Paul adds that those who disparage ethnic Israel are putting themselves at risk of being cut off, and it is part of the reason (I believe) for the Lord's warning in Revelation 2:21-23:

Let's read that passage now:

And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works. (Rev 2:21-23)

So, what is this warning all about? Are we talking about minor doctrinal differences like how often we take communion, and other such matters? I don't think so.

Now, imagine if the church at Laodicea was last to receive its letter of rebuke from the Lord – a letter that we find in this same passage of Revelation.

Imagine if those at Laodicea got word somehow that their sister churches had received such letters, but having not yet received one of their own, they then assumed they would not receive such a letter.

Those at Laodicea might have then said to themselves, "I knew it! Those people over at Ephesus are total nutters! They should close that place up and come over to our church, which is the only true church anyway!"

How should we describe that kind of reaction toward those in the other houses of worship?

I believe we might describe it as "ecclesial supremacy," or the belief that my church is the only true church, a common belief held throughout modern Christendom.

I will close by saying that the four part harvest will be kind to those of us who remain repentant and less kind to those who walk in pride, as the passage above makes very clear.

Let us pray for one another as we continue to Hear what the Spirit is saying to the Churches:

"Behold, I come quickly!"
